The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine has approved the procedure for monitoring the drug and alcohol situation in Ukraine as well as a list of subjects who will be tasked with monitoring the situation and providing information/data on the state of processes and phenomena in the field of psychoactive substance circulation for further analysis.

The decision was reached by the government seeking to put in place a state-level drug and alcohol monitoring mechanism. Anti-drug trafficking and illicit use of narcotics and psychotropic substances, therapy, rehabilitation and re-socialization of people who are addicted will all benefit from this mechanism.

Issues of Monitoring Drug and Alcohol Situation in Ukraine

The Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine decides on as follows:

1. To accept the Ministry of Health's recommendation to establish monitoring of the drug and alcohol situation in Ukraine.

2. To approve the Procedure for Monitoring of Drug and Alcohol Situation in Ukraine.

3. To set up that funding for drug and alcohol monitoring measures in Ukraine will be limited to allocations of the state and local budgets for ministries, other central executive authorities, the Council of Ministers of the Autonomous Republic of Crimea, regional, Kyiv, and Sevastopol city state administrations, as well as other legal sources.
